Erasmus+ programme has launched its 2024 Call for Proposals. The Call includes a range of opportunities for Pakistani Higher Education Institutes (HEIs), organisations and individuals/students. This international dimension is usually based on a partnership between HEIs and organisations from countries such as Pakistan, working with those in 33 EU Member States and/or third countries associated to the programme. Following components of Erasmus+ programme are available to Pakistani HEIs, organisations and individuals/students.

- i. Erasmus Mundus Joint Masters (EMJM) and Erasmus Mundus Design Measures (EMDM)
- ii. Erasmus Mundus Scholarships for Joint Masters Degree Courses
- iii. Capacity Building for Higher Education (CBHE)
- iv. International Credit Mobility (ICM)
- v. Jean Monnet (JM) Actions
